



A Draught of a tract of Land Called Baker Hall situate on a small stream of water that empties into the North East Branch of Susq^a River in a tract of Land formerly surveyed and returned for David Reynolds in the County of Northumberland and adjoining land surveyed for Abraham Liddon containing Two hundred and eighty five acres & one hundred and four perches besides the usual allowance of 6 p cent for Roads & sta surveyed the 7th day of June 1774. for Joseph Baker in pursuance of a warrant dated the 15th day of March 1774
