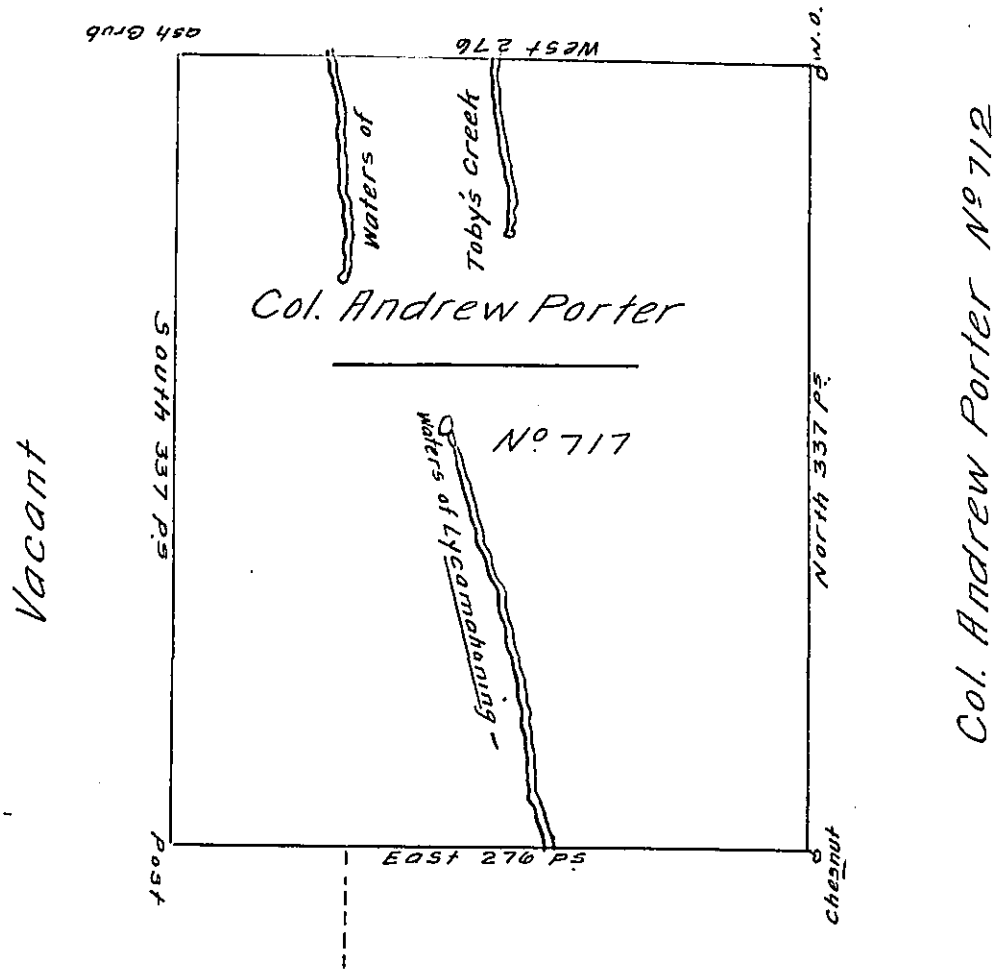


Col. Andrew Porter
