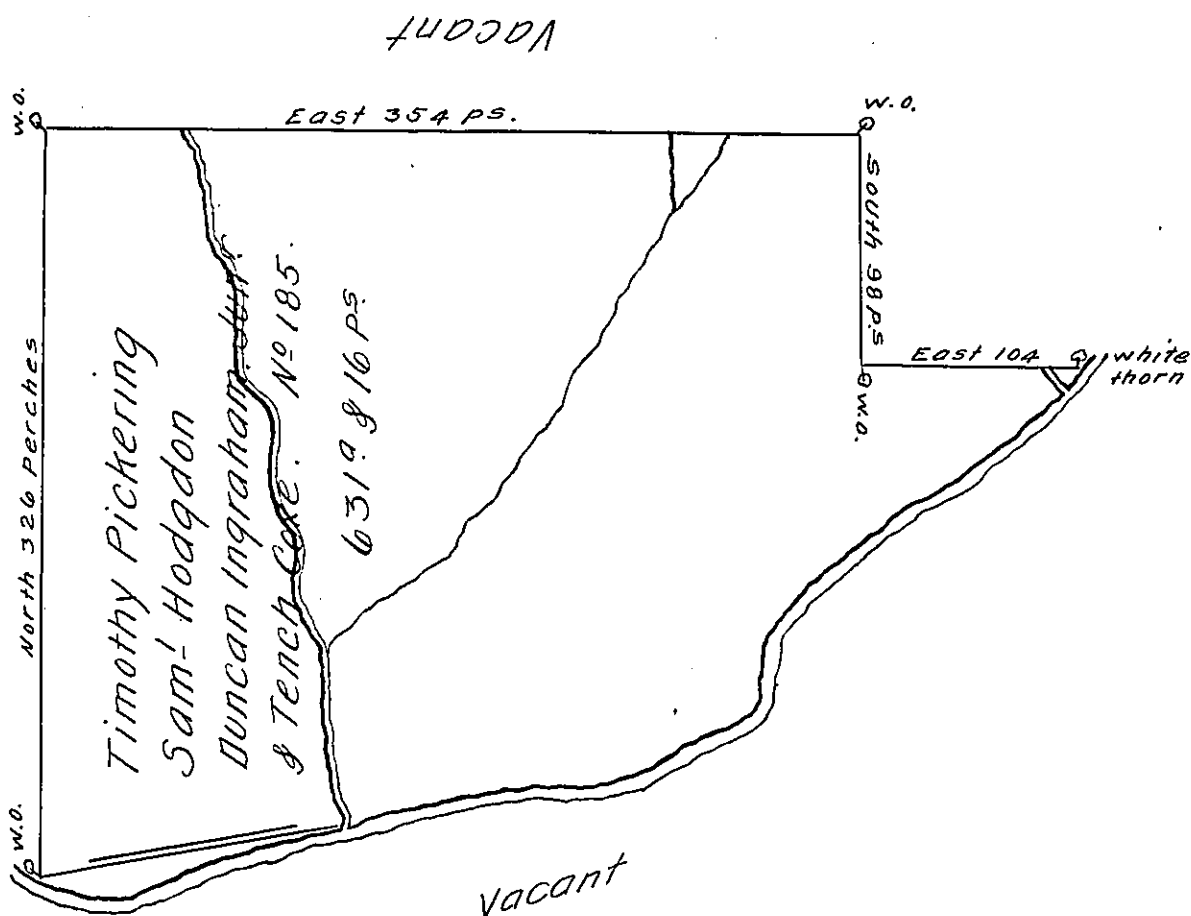

Containing six hundred and thirty one Acres and sixteen perches with the usual Allowance of six Cent for Roads &c^a Surveyed for Timothy Pickering, Saml. Hodgdon, Duncan Ingraham Junr and Tench Coxe the 2^d Day of June 1786. In Pursuance of a Warrant Dated May 17th 1785. No 185.
