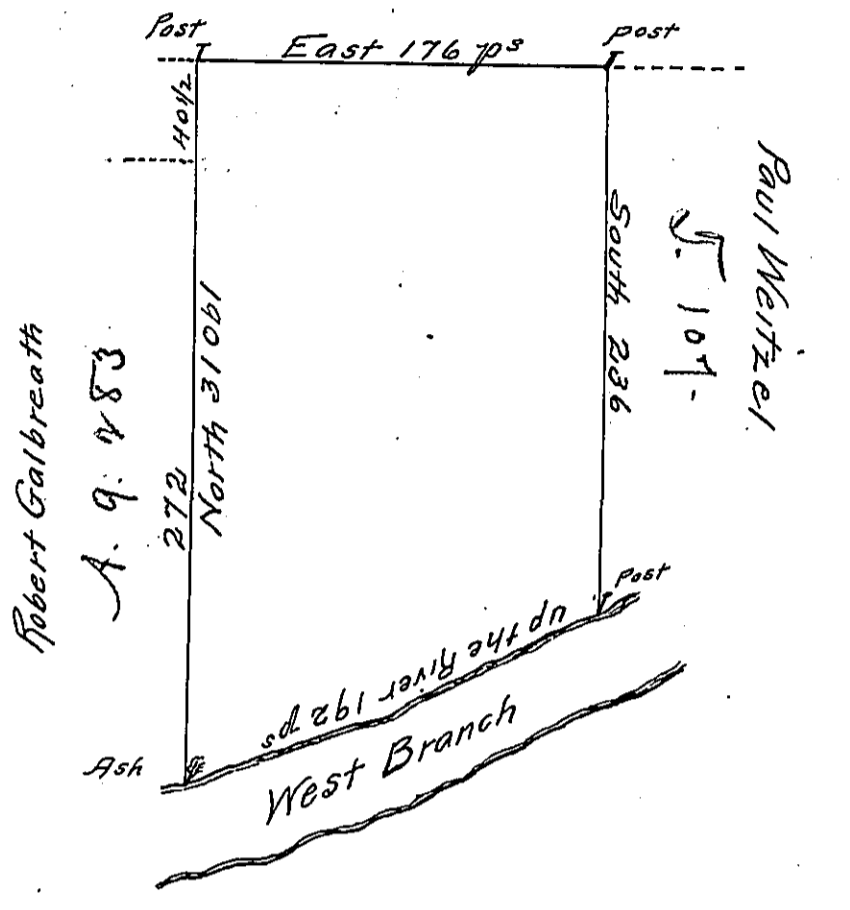


Phoelix Pickley
