

Situate in Norwegian township, Schuylkill county, containing one hundred and seventy three acres and thirty two perches and the allowance of six per cent, it being part of a larger tract of land that was originally surveyed on the 5<sup>th</sup> day of June 1815 in pursuance of a Warrant dated 23<sup>rd</sup> day of May 1815 granted to John Adams as appears from a Draught on record in my office. Divided off the 11<sup>th</sup> day of June 1828 and returned for Michael Heberling.

The improvements are a log house, barn and saw mill and about 10<sup>acres</sup> cleared land, said to have been commenced in 1799.
