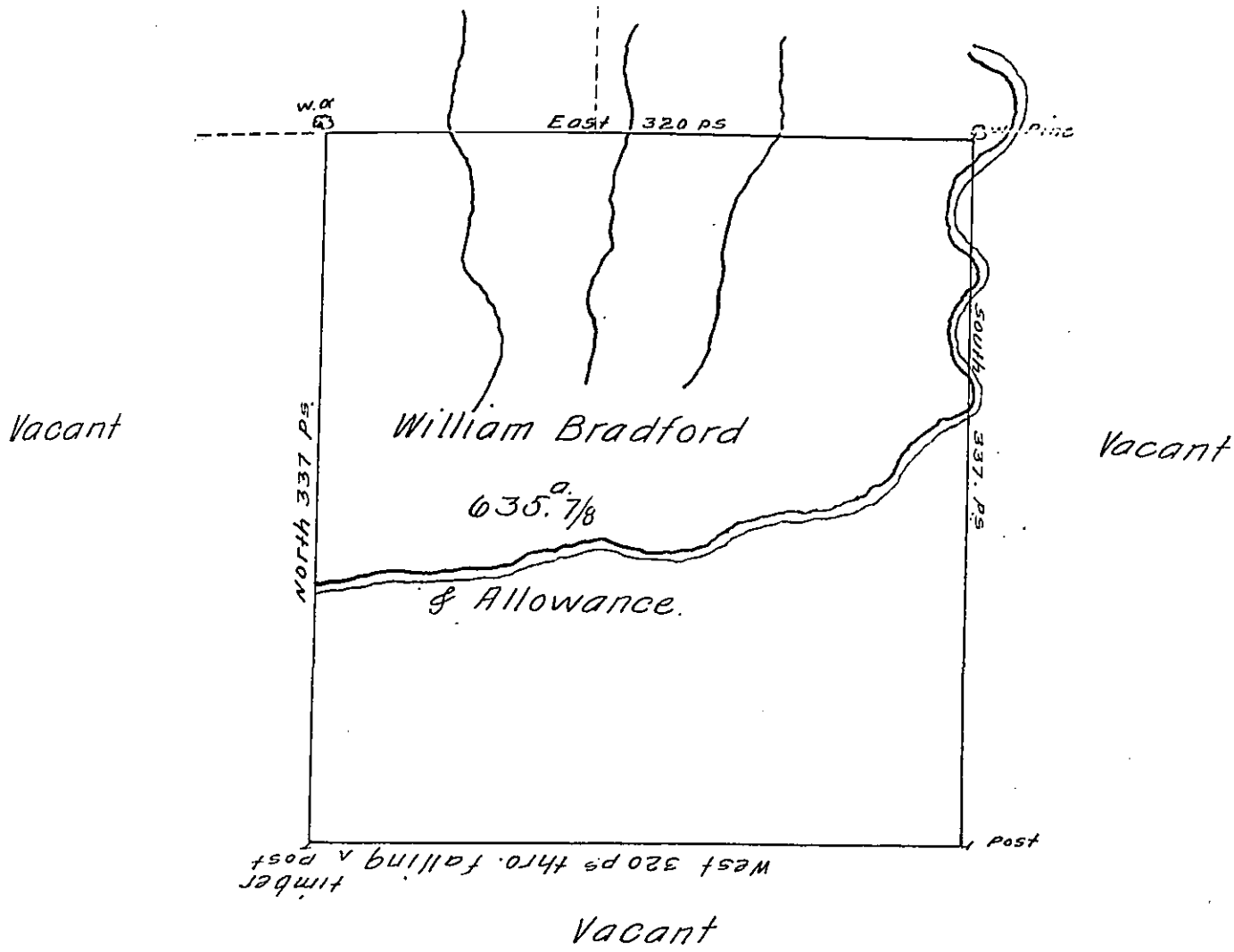


Jon<sup>d</sup> D. Serjeant
