



A draught of a tract of land called \_\_\_\_\_ situate on the south side of the North East branch of Susquehanna River adjoining the Honorable the Proprietaries Manor of Pomfret and land surveyed for Casper Shafner in the County of Northumberland containing three hundred and thirty four acres and a half acre besides the usual allowance of six  $\frac{1}{2}$  cent. for roads &c. Surveyed the 28<sup>th</sup> day of November 1774 for Peter Shafner in pursuance of a warrant dated the 29<sup>th</sup> day of June 1774
