



The above is the draught of a tract of land formerly called, and hereafter to be known by the name of the "Chest" situate on the old trading path leading from Frankstown to the Kittanning &c. and about three miles beyond the Clearfields, in Cumberland County; containing eight hundred and eighty eight acres, one hundred and seven perches and the usual allowance of six 7/8 cent. for roads &c. Surveyed the 20th and 21st days of March A. D. 1769 for Alexander Stewart in pursuance of an order No 18 dated the 17th day of February 1769.
