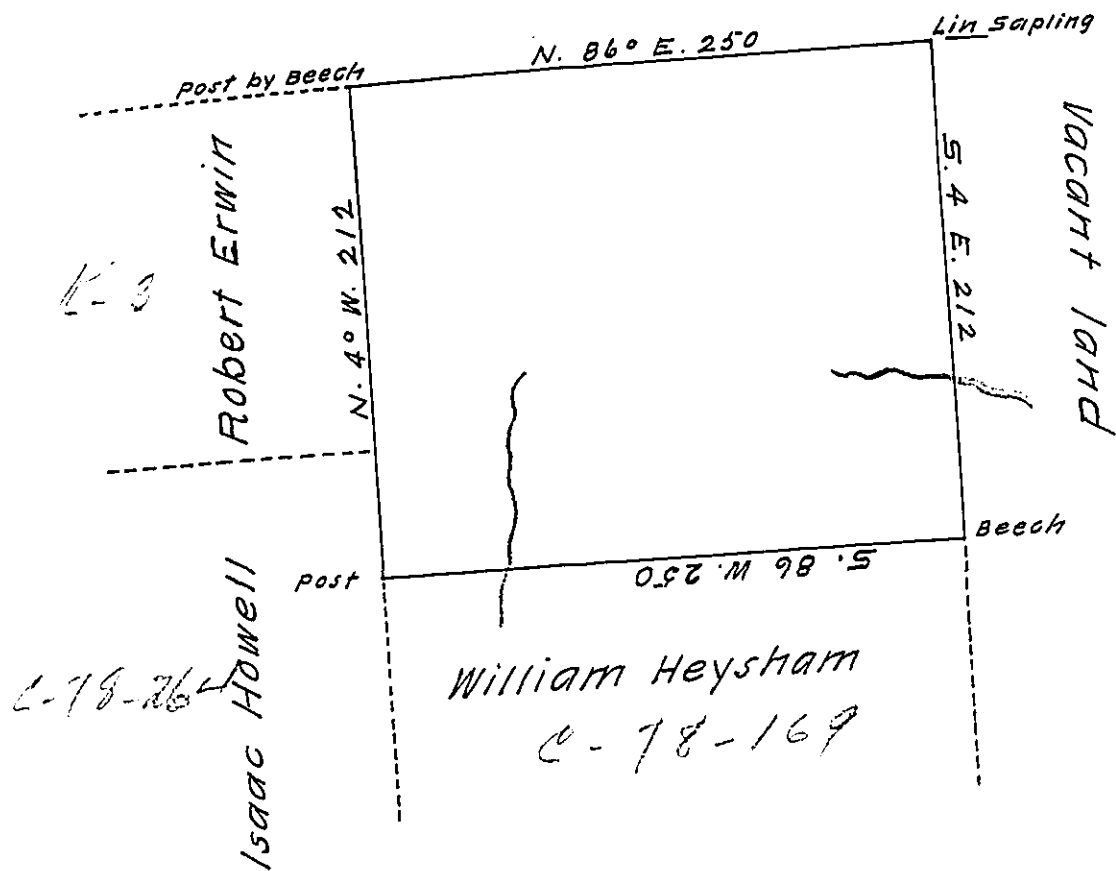


Vacant land
