



Situate in Norwegian township Schuylkill County (formerly Berks) containing 182<sup>9</sup>/<sub>16</sub> 14<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> & allowance part of 213<sup>9</sup>/<sub>16</sub> 32<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> & allowance which was survey—for John C. Offerman in right of Francis Umbelocker on the 14<sup>th</sup> day of October 1838 on a warrant dated 12<sup>th</sup> June 1794 (and said to have been surveyed on 12<sup>th</sup> Nov<sup>r</sup> 1796) the lines and corners counting 41 years. Resurvey'd for John C. Offerman May 13, 1839.
