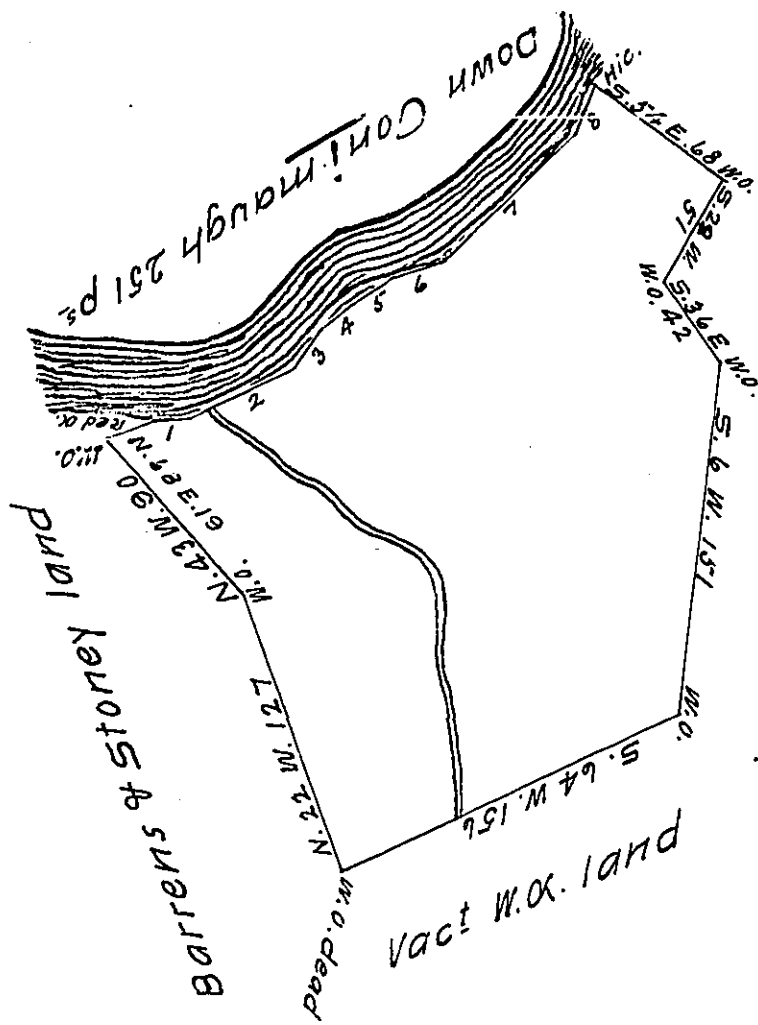

In pursuance of an order No 39 and dated the 24th day of May 1769 survey'd the above discribed tract of land for John Campbell, called the Recovery, containing two hundred and eighty two acres & 98 perches with an allowance proportioned to 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ cent. situate near the fort on Connimough & on a small creek called M^cGees Run at his hunting cabbin. Survey'd June the 5th 1769
