N.B. The above survey is included by a paper, or Cham-
bers survey made in the name of John Brady on a warr-
ant dated the 18th November 1793 (I have not been able
to find any marks on the ground corisponding with the
date of the Jno Brady³ Survey A. Houts of Union County, Lewis
Dewart, Henry Masser & others of North^d County claim
the Brady survey I am not able to say waht their claim
is founded on.

John Jones the owner of a warrant dated 18th Feb. 1830
survey'd 26th May 1830 the survey of George Mowrie as now made
& includes a portion of land claim'd by said Jones who wishes
this to opprate as a caveat that he may have a hearing
before the Board of property previous to a patent issu
ing.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in
the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made
conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of
February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused
the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg,
this nineteenth day of December 1911
