



A draught of a tract of land called \_\_\_\_\_ situate on the east side of the north east branch of Susquehanna River on a Creek called Rummerfields Creek about eight miles above Wyalosing in the County of Northumberland containing fifty three acres and a half acre besides the usual allowance of six  $\frac{7}{8}$  cent for roads &c. Surveyed the 21<sup>st</sup> day of October 1774 for Jacob Van Reed in pursuance of a warrant dated the 19<sup>th</sup> day of August 1774
