



A Draught of a Tract of Land called — Situate on the Southerly side of the North East Branch of Susquehanna River adjoining land Surveyed for John Patton, George Miller and others in the County of Northumberland containing three hundred and thirty Acres and three Quarters of an Acre beside the usual allowance of Six & Cent for Roads &c. Surveyed the first day of August 1774 for Isaac Gray in Pursuance of a Warrant dated 17<sup>th</sup> Aug<sup>r</sup> 1773.
