The draught of a tract of land called — situate in Kishacoquillis valey Cumberland County. containing two hundred twenty acres 64 perches with the usual Allow. of six acres & Cent for Roads. Resurvey'd the 9th day of January A. Dom. 1772 (agreeable to the lines of an old Survey formerly made by Col. Armstrong) in pursuance of a Warrant from the honble. Proprietaries to John Alexander bearing date at Philad^a the 4th of February A. D. 1755.
