



A Draught of a Tract of Land Situate in Tyrone Twp. in the County of Cumberland Survey'd in dispute betwixt Margaret Porter, and Robert Hearse by their several Warrants containing 270 1/2 ac the Prick'd line serves to Represent the Division Recommended to these contending parties, according to which Margaret Porters part wou'd contain 155 3/4 ac and that of Robert Hearse 114 3/4 ac. but said Margaret wou'd not agree to this nor any other Division but appeals to the Secretary & Surveyor Genl.

I have taken much pains in this Survey & Survey'd all the Land I cou'd with any degree of reason, also cast out such as was insufficient in ye former Survey complain'd of Margaret Porter, by which means the quantity does not fully satisfy the Warrants of both; nevertheless shou'd a division be order'd, Hearse's Warrants which only are now defective, may by extending the lines into Stoney Ground, be fill'd also, or remain as they are, if he is Content.
