



A Draught of a Tract of Land Situate in Paradise Township in the County of York containing three Hundred and fourteen Acres and the Allowance of six Acres & Cent for Roads and Highways. Part of it was Surveyed for John Ermil the 7th Day of November 1749 by Thomas Cookson Esquire late Deputy Surveyor of Lancaster County. but not closed nor finished. them Lines were examined and the whole Survey made for the said John Ermil as the above Draught appears the 7th Day of May 1756. in pursuance of a Warrant granted to him (by the Name of John Armwell) the 19th day of May 1752.
