



By Virtue of a Warrant of Resurvey Granted to Richard Hockley Esq<sup>e</sup> the Tenth Day of July 1762 and in pursuance of a special Order from the Surveyor General dated at Philad<sup>a</sup> October 13<sup>th</sup>. 1767 the above described Tract of Land S-obl- in Cumberland County about four miles Northward from-obl- upon a small run that empties into Dunings Creek by-obl- Brushy run and containing Three Hundred & seventy-obl- acres and the usual allowance of six p<sup>t</sup> Cent) was Resurveyed November the 3<sup>d</sup> 1767.
