



In pursuance of an Act of Assembly passed the 12<sup>th</sup> day of March 1783 for the sale of certain land there in mentioned and by virtue of a Commission under the hand seal of office of John Lukens Esq<sup>r</sup> Surveyor General for the State of Pennsylvania to me directed bearing date at Philad<sup>a</sup> the 19<sup>th</sup> day of August 1783 the above tract of land containing two hundred and fifty two acres seven perches and allowance of six per cent for roads &c<sup>a</sup> was surveyed on the 27<sup>th</sup> Day of July 1785 by
