



By Virtue of a Warr^t from the Honble the Proprietaries dated the 27th of May 1734 Granted to Thomas Fitzwater William Luken and Joseph Nash to Resurvey and divide 500^{ac} of Land in the tenure of the Persons aforesaid and being a Tract formerly laid out to William Salloway situate in the Township of Upper Dublin in the County ~~of~~ of Philad^a I Resurveyed the said tract on the 5th day of April 1740 and found the Quantity to be 545 acres with allowance of Six & Cent and on the same day divided the same in ^{the} Manner above Described
