Containing 23<sup>ac.</sup> 6<sup>ps.</sup> and the Usual Allowance for Roads. Survey'd the 13<sup>th</sup> day of October 1792. In pursuance of a Warrant dated the 31<sup>st</sup> day of July 1792.
