I agree that a patent issue on a survey and resurvey in the name of Jeremiah Jackson in Little Mahanoy town-ship North^d County. on War^t dated 14th March 1794 adjoining Cooke, Gray & others. without including a small interference of about 5 acres on the N boundary or an interference which runs across the S. end of said tract. For Benjⁿ Taylor & myself.

Situate in Little Mahanoy Township Northumberland County. Contain-
ing (with the interference) four hundred twenty eight Acres & fifty
perches & allowance of Six per Cent & c. Surveyed the 11th November
1794 unto Jeremiah Jackson by virtue of his War^t dated 14th March
1794 by W^m Gray then D. S. of North^d County. And Resurveyed on the
26th day of Dec^r. 1828. in pursuance of an Order of the Board of
Property. granted to Hugh Bellas dated on the 29th day of Novem-
ber 1828.
