



A Draught of a Tract of Land. Situate in Maccongy Township in the County of Northampton in the State of Pennsylvania. Being Part of a Tract of 87^{3/4} Acres. etc. That was Surveyed to Edward Jarret. by Virtue of a Warrant dated on the 12th April Anno-1753. who sold his Right in the above Part thereof. Containing Thirty Seven Acres and 118 Perches of Land, and the usual Allowance at Six per Cent for Roads. To Peter Miller, Who again sold the Same To Frederick Fannel, Who also on the 28th March Anno-1788 Sold and Conveyed his Right To the Same To Daniel Good - formerly Surveyed and now drawn. By Order of the Surveyor General for the Said Daniel Good. on the 10th February Anno-1789.
