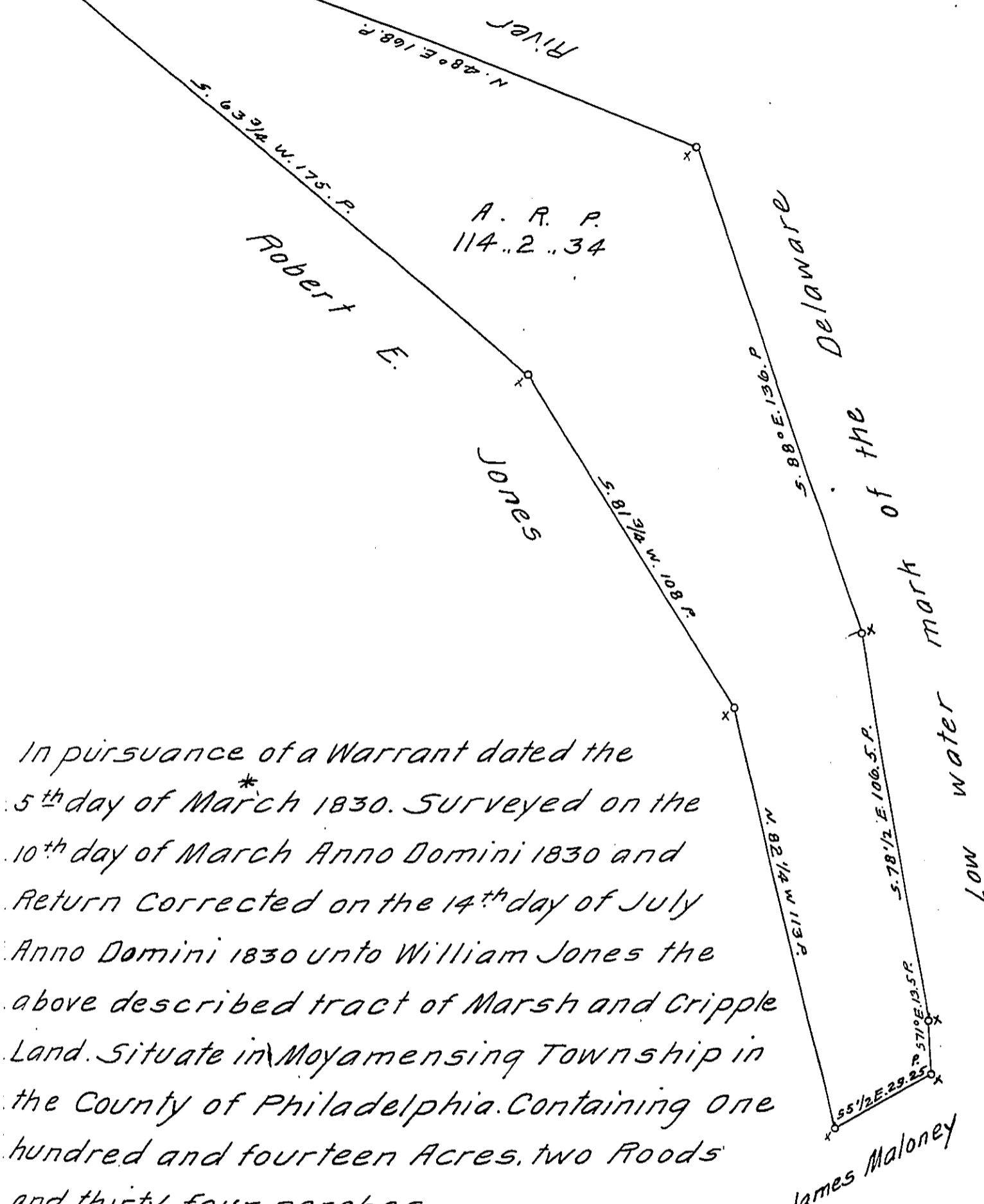


Land believed to be vacant

Situate in Moyamensing Township in the County of Philadelphia. Containing one hundred and fourteen Acres, two Roods and thirty four perches.
