



A Draught of a Tract of Land Sit-

uate in Hereford Township in the County of Berks and Province of Pennsylvania. Being Part of a Tract of 107^{acres} 33 Perches and the Allowance. That was formally surveyed by John Scull unto Hieronimus Graber by Warrant granted to Martin Keler. dated on the 21st May Anno-1748. The said Graber on the 3rd May 1769. Sold the same to his Son George Graber- who now sold the above Part thereof unto Mathias Ludwig- Beginning at a Stone a Corner of Christian German's Land. Thence by the same. South West 79 1/2 perches to a Stone near the Line of Peter Federolph's Land. Thence by the same, and by Land of Henry Wetzel (late Dewald Beck) North West. 97. perches to a Stone. Thence by the said Henry Wetzel's Land North 8 degrees East 28 1/2 perches to a Stone. Set for a Corner of Jacob Berger's Land. Thence by the same South 89 1/2 degrees East 102 perches to a Stone in the Line of Jacob Wetzel's Land. Thence by the same South 25 degrees East 44 perches to the Place of Beginning. - Containing Forty five Acres and 40 Perches of Land together with the usual Allowance at Six per Cent for Roads. - Or Forty Seven Acres and 155 Perches strict measure. Surveyed for the said Mathias Ludwig on the 7th June Anno-1771.
