



Situate in Schuylkill township, Schuylkill county, containing four hundred and one acres and eighteen perches and the allowance of six per cent. said to have been surveyed on the 6th day of May 1794. in pursuance of a warrant dated the 19th day of November 1793 granted Daniel Kercher as appears by an official copy of the return of survey made into the Surveyor General's office. Resurveyed on the 2^d day of September 1826 in pursuance of an order of the Board of Property dated the 30th day of March 1826.
