



By Virtue of a Warrant dated - June 12th 1794 Surveyed
 the 16th of May 1795 Unto George - Eckert the above desc-
 ribed Tract of Three hundred and twenty eight Acres & 124 prs of Land and
 Allowance. Situated near and adjoining the North Branch of the River Susque-
 hanna between the mouth of Fishing Creek and the Ferry at Catawassy on
 the West side of said River in Mahoning Township North^{bd} County.

Note. the above Tract of Land had been Surveyed 17th July 1790 on a War-
 rant to Bernard Kepple dated 15th of June 1774 by the direction of John
 Mears then Administrator to the Estate of Dennis Leary deceased. whose prop-
 erty the said Warrant was then supposed to be, but now is claimed by Valentine
 Eckert. and it is insisted on that it ought not to have been laid on the above
 land. but on land Survey'd 10th May 1790 on a Warrant to John Mears Dated
 Nov^{br} 11th 1786. but which did not precisly call for that land; And further
 it is a fact that in order that the description in Bernard Kepple sh-
 ould be fully satisfied. A part of the Land Surveyed both on Mears's
 and Kepple's Warrants ought to be included in Kepples Survey as will
 be seen by the description in said Warrant compared with the ad-
 joining Lands.
