



Situate on the head waters of Juniatta — in Greenfield Township Bedford County. Containing $383\frac{1}{4}^{as}$ and allowance of six p.c.t. for Roads. &c. first surveyed in the Year 1794. in persuance of a Warrant granted to George John dated the 12th day of March 1794. but not Returned. Re-surveyed under the directions of James Piper ^{Esq. late D.S.} the 8th day of April 1830. & Returned into the Surveyor Generals Office the 2nd of June 1830. and on Examination it appeared not to table. Examined & corrected from the Original field Notes the 15th day of Feb^r. 1831.
