



Situate near the Cumberland Road in Wharton township Fayette County, and Surveyed the 11<sup>th</sup> day of July 1835. In pursuance of a Warrant in the name of Green Lee, for 400<sup>as</sup> dated the 10<sup>th</sup> day of February 1794, there is a small improvement of 2 or 3 acres commenced about a year ago, and a log house on this tract. Owing to the irregular form of many of the Surveys, as caused by the claiments, this tract was thrown out of its intended connection, but as it joins John Clerk, one of the Same chain, and as I know of no adverse claim to the land, I have ventured to return it & hope it may be accepted.
