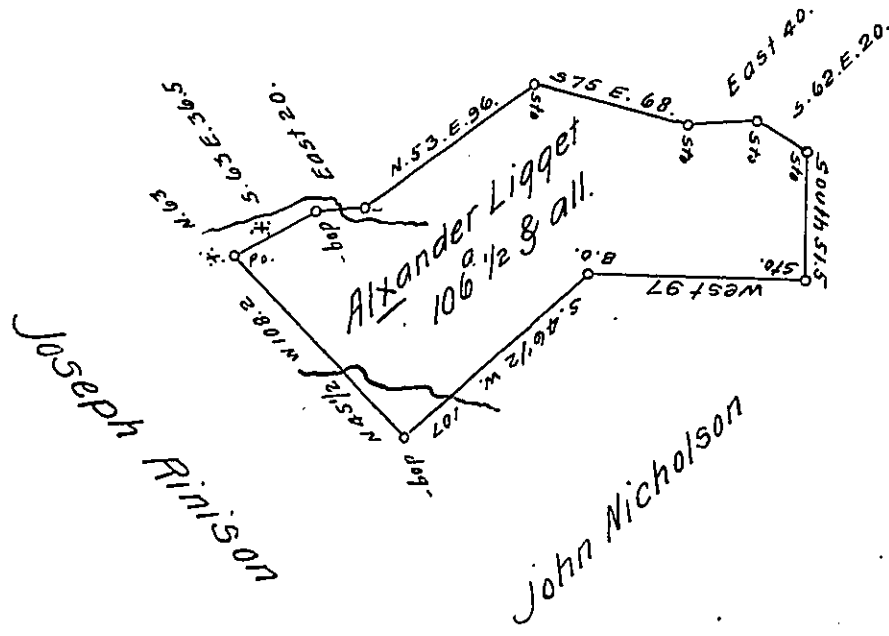


Jacob Smith
