It is suggested that the above Survey includes Six Hundred Acres of Land claimed by The Corn-Planter a Chief of the Seneca Nation of Indians. by Virtue of a Special Grant of the Assembly of Pennsylvania. This is therefore present^d. subject to an Enquiry respecting the Same.
