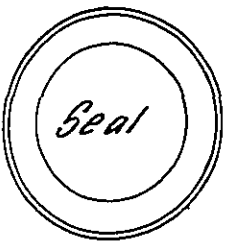

These are to authorize and require you to survey and lay out the Quantity of Five Thousand Acres of Land South West of William proctors Improvement about fourteen Miles from Ligonier in the County of Cumberland and to make Return thereof for our Use into our Secretaries Office For which this shall be your sufficient Warrant Witness John Penn Esq^r Lieutenant Governor & Commissioner of Property of the s^d province who by virtue of certain powers from the s^d proprietaries hath hereunto set his Hand and caused the Seal of the Land Office to be affixed at Philadelphia this twenty second Day of February in the Year of our Lord One thousand seven hundred & sixty nine
