



In pursuance of an Act of Assembly passed the 12th day of March 1783 for the sale of certain lands therein mentioned, and by virtue of a Commission under the hand and seal of office of John Lukens Esq^r. Surveyor Generall for the state of Pennsylvania to me directed bearing date the 14th day of August 1783 the above tract containing two hundred and forty five acres forty five perches and allowance of six Per cent for roads &c^a was surveyed on the 29th day of June 1785 by
