



In pursuance of an order Nº 2917. dated the 7<sup>th</sup> of April 1769 Survey'd for Thomas Burbridge the above described tract of Land (called Necessity) Containing two hundred & fitty seven acres and 23 perches, with an allowance proportioned to 6 pcent. Situate about two Miles from the Mouth of Conimaugh near Black Logs Old Town, in Bedford County Survey'd the 17<sup>th</sup> of December 1771.
