



The above is the Draught of a Tract of Land situate in Bern Township Berks County containing altogether ~~226~~ 105 P & allowance - The tract at A containing 162<sup>A</sup>.146 P & allowance surveyed to Christian Miller by virtue of a Warrant Dated the 15th of September 1747 - The tracts B & C containing 63<sup>A</sup>.119 P & allowance both appears to have been surveyed by virtue of an Application to Henry Stehley dated the 21<sup>st</sup> of October 1766. No 1970 both copied <sup>from</sup> Mordecai Yarnal's Draughts who surveyed for James Scull & John Scull - & the Tract A from Benjamin Lightfoot's field book - the 31<sup>st</sup> of the 3<sup>rd</sup> mo 1788. by Thomas Lightfoot.
