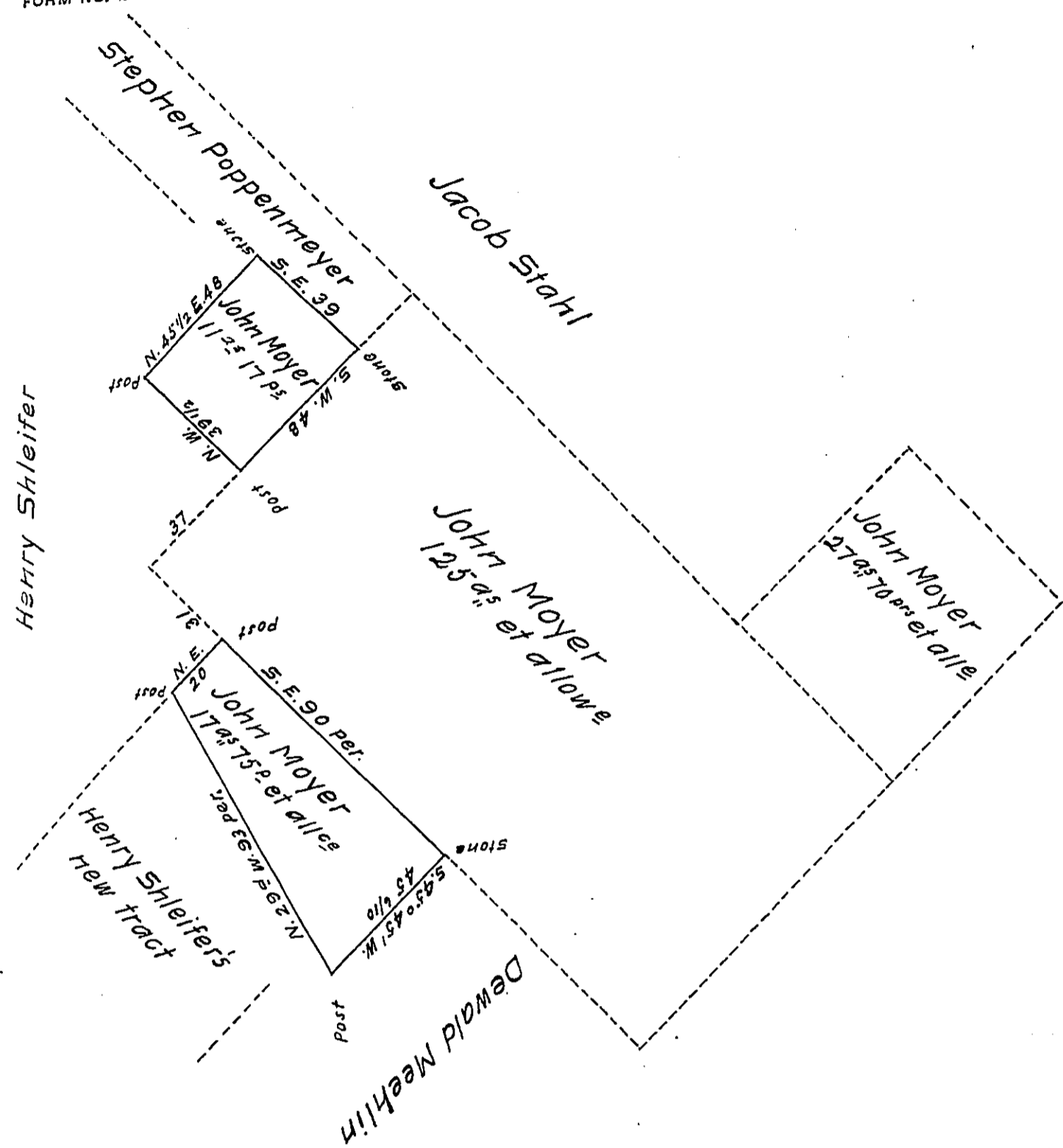


FORM NO. 1.



By virtue of a warrant dated at Philadelphia on the 4th day of December Anno — 1754 the above described two tracts of land situate in Upper Milford township in the County of Northampton and Province of Pennsylvania; The one containing seventeen acres and 75 perches of land with the allowance, and the other contains eleven acres and 17 perches of land, together with the usual allowance at six per cent for roads.
