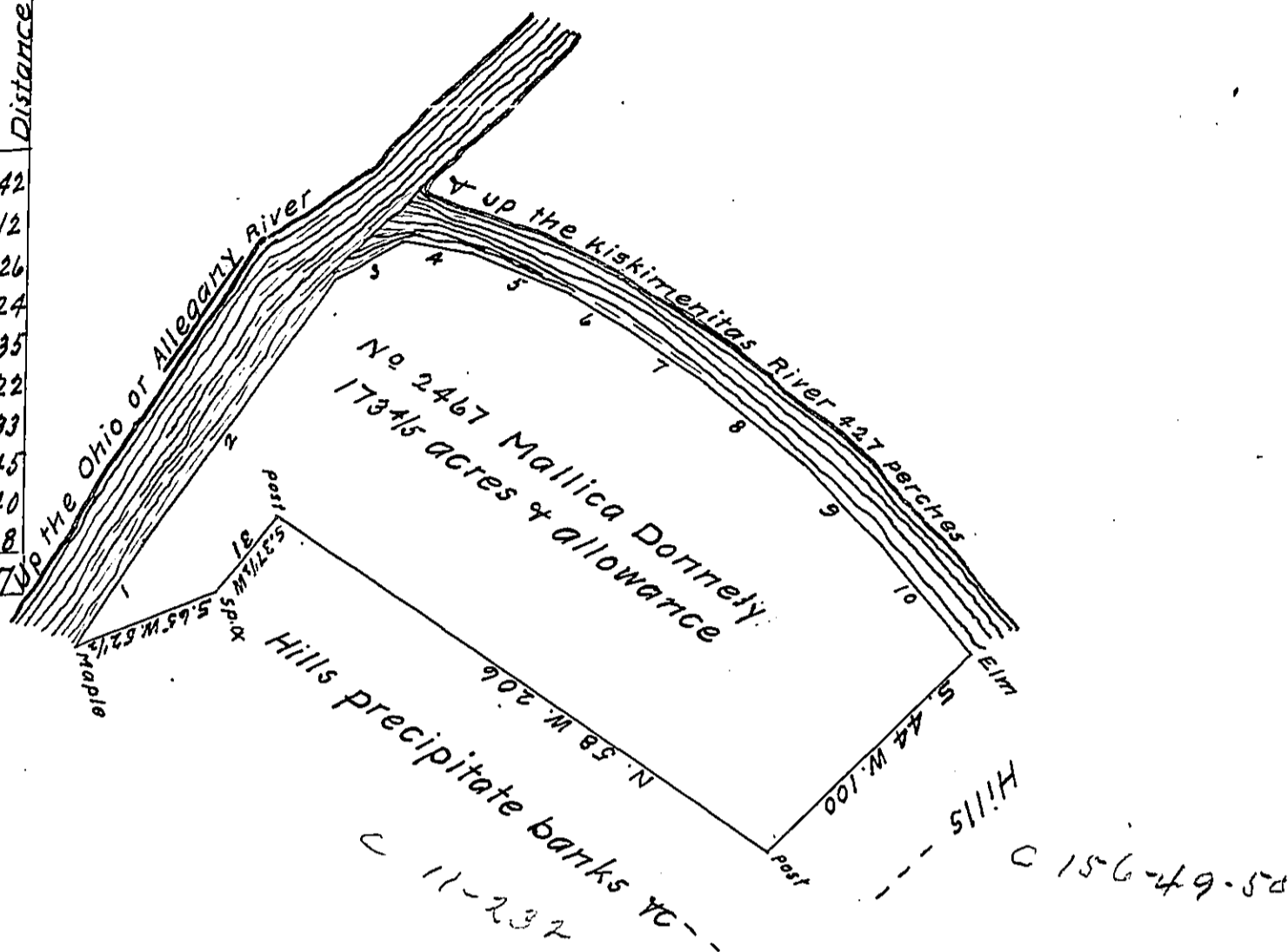

In pursuance of an order No 2467 dated the 3^d of April 1769 survey'd for Mallica Donnelly the above described tract of land containing one hundred and seventy three acres $\frac{4}{5}$ of an acre with an allowance proportioned to six pr. cent. situate on the South side of the Kiskiminitas, intersecting with Allegany River in Westmoreland County, survey'd the 30th of April 1770:
