



In pursuance of an order No 3631 dated the 10th of July 1769 survey'd for Robert Beatty the above described tract of land containing two hundred & ninety nine acres & one half acre with an allowance proportioned to 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ cent, situate on the right hand of the road leading to Fort Pitt near Turtle Creek joining John Sampsons land in Westmoreland County &c. Survey'd the first of November 1769 $\frac{1}{2}$.
