



A draught of a survey lying on Robinson's Run in Washington County cont'g 349 acs & 113 ps executed Aug<sup>st</sup> 24<sup>th</sup> 1785 in pursuance of a certificate in the name of Jno McDonald for 400 acs granted him by the Commiss<sup>rs</sup> appointed by Virg<sup>a</sup> to adjust the titles to unpatented lands in the Counties of Monongalia, York<sup>a</sup> & Ohio and regularly entered with the County Surv<sup>r</sup> as appears by the authanticated copy of entries transmitted from the Surv<sup>r</sup>-Gen<sup>l</sup> Office. Entered 27<sup>th</sup> April 1780.
