



The above is a draught of a tract of land called Hayes Bottom upon the waters of Racoon Creek Washington County surveyed Oct^r 28th 1785 for Geo. McCarmick Cont^g three hundred and fifty nine acres in consequence of a certificate from the Commissioners of Virginia Viz. We the Commissioners for adjusting claims to unpatented lands in the Counties of Monong^a, Yog^t and Ohio do hereby certify that Geo. McCarmick is entitled to four hundred acres of land in Yohogan^a County upon the waters of Racoon to include his actual settlement made in the year 1775. Given under our hands at Coxes Fort the 18th Feb^y 1780 in the fourth year of the Commonwealth.
