



A draught of a survey situate on the waters of Peters Ck in Washington County contain^g 210 ac^s strict measure (called Donegall) executed May the 9th 1786 in consequence of a certif^e granted to Wm M^e Mullin for 200 ac^s by the Commiss^{rs} appointed by Virginia to adjust the claims to unpatented in the Counties Monongahela, Yohg^a and Ohio.
