A draught of a tract of land situate in Huntingdon township in the County of York containing three hundred and twenty four acres and the allowance of six acres $\frac{1}{100}$ cent. for roads & highways first survey'd by Mr Cookson the lines examined & the piece marked B. (between the dotted lines and the Run) added the 29th day of August 1755, for John McGrew in pursuance of a warrant bearing date the 26th day of July 1745. The right whereof is vested in Archibald McGrew.
