Thomas Armor for John McCalla now resurveyed the 2d of the 1st mo. 1772 in pursuance of an order of the Board of Property dated the 31st of December 1770 ~~dat~~ on caveat McCalla against Kersey directing me to examine the lines. I find that McCalla had two surveys made, one of 135 a and and a small oblong of about 4 a about 80 prs from the other but afterwards altered the large survey and paid no regard to the 4 a piece and had 315 a returned, but I find that survey to contain 350 a 10 pr & 0 a and that McCalla's house and spring is not included in either of them I herewith send all the draughts.
