Klugh at a place called Honame in the County of Cumberland containing two hundred and sixty three acres and three quarters of an acre besides the usual allowance of 6<sup>th</sup> cent for Roads &c. Surveyed the 25<sup>th</sup> day of August 1774 for Saml. Nichols in pursuance of a warrant dated the 9<sup>th</sup> day of May 1774.
