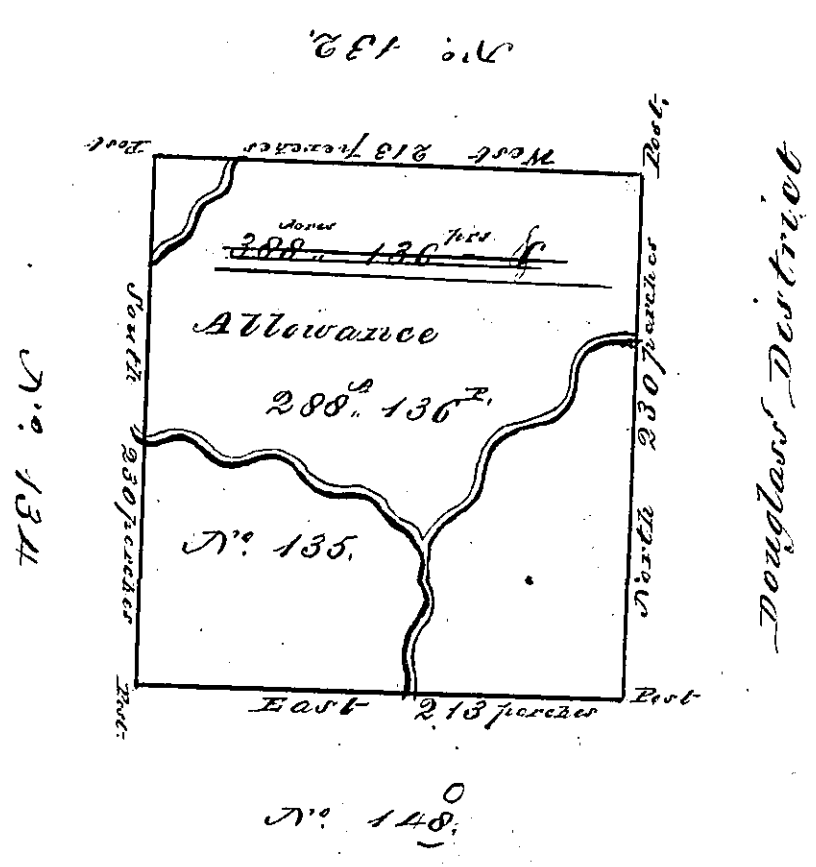

In pursuance of an Act of Assembly passed the 12<sup>th</sup> day of March 1783 for the sale of certain lands therein mentioned and by virtue of a Commission under the hands and seal of office of John Lukens Esquire Surveyor General for the State of Pennsylvania to me directed bearing date at Philadelphia the 14<sup>th</sup> day of August 1783 the above tract of land containing ~~three~~ two hundred & eighty eight acres one hundred and thirty six perches and allowance of six per cent for Roads &c. was surveyed on the 23<sup>d</sup> day of July 1785 by
