



A draught of a Lot of Ground situate in the Town of Carlisle in the County of Cumberland, marked in the General Plan of said Town numbered ninety-four, situate on the South side of Towther Street, containing in Breadth on Towther Street East & West sixty feet, and in Length North and South, Two hundred and forty feet, Bounded Northward by Towther Street aforesaid, Westward by Lot Number Eighty six, Southward by a Twenty feet alley, and Eastward by Lot Number One hundred and two. Returned into the Secretary's office the 28th day of Nov: 1746 for James Polk, By Warrant of the 27th of Nov: 1746.
