

By Virtue of a Warrant dated the 1st July 1784 Surveyed the 18th October 1785 to Thomas braig the above described tract of Land Situate on a large stream of Water on the Northern boundary of Pennsylvania, Beginning one mile and two hundred and ninety four perches Mest of Delaware River on the State line & about half a mile the Confluence of Laid loreek with the Delaware in Northampton county containing Four Hundred & forty acres one hundred and fifteen perches and the allowance of Six poent be.
