



A Draught of a tract of land called Spring Grove, Situate on the fords of Beaver Meadow Run, about half a mile to the Northward of the old road leading from Bedford to Fort Pitt; adjoining lands of William Fisher, Stephen Barricks, and William Fisher Junior, in Cumberland County, Containing Two hundred and eighty nine acres and the usual allowance of six p. cent for roads &c, Surveyed the 18th day of September 1770 for Samuel Fisher of the City of Philadelphia, by virtue of a Warrant granted to him the 2^d day of July in the year aforesaid
