

above return.

Situate in Todd Township Huntingdon County  
containing four hundred forty acres & the usual allowance  
of 6 per cent for roads &c. Survey'd <sup>December the 6<sup>th</sup> 1847</sup> ~~November 4<sup>th</sup> 1847~~ In pursuance  
of a warrant granted to James Entrikin for four hundred  
acres dated the 29<sup>th</sup> day of May 1847 - Int from 19<sup>th</sup> March 1820.
