



Situate on a Branch of Polands' Run in Franklin Town-  
 ship Fayette County, and is the principal part of a survey made for said  
 Hall by Warrant dated the 15th day of April 1776 and returned into the Sur-  
 veyor General's Office, but was afterwards caveated by John Carmichael  
 submitted to referees or auditors appointed by the parties, and certified  
 by the honorable Board of Property, in consequence of which there was a  
 small part of the land adjudged to John Carmichael, which has made  
 it necessary to alter the survey, as well to conform with that of Carmi-  
 chal, as the better to accommodate another survey in the name of Mar-  
 garet Hall adjacent thereto, there having been a considerable quan-  
 tity taken from it by prior right in the name of James Cray of the Certifi-  
 cate &c.
